

- Tobii Sono Flex is an easy to use AAC vocabulary app that turns symbols into clear speech and provides language to nonverbal users who are not yet in full control of literacy




- First-Then allows schedules to be created "on the go" and customized to the needs of the individual. Schedules can be created to show daily events or steps need to complete a specific activity or daily events.



Stories2Learn


- This app provides a framework to create personalized stories using photos, text, and audio messages. These stories can be used to promote an individual's literacy, leisure, social skills.


